#### **Takeaways**

- As of 2023 the region's population increased by 10.4% since 2018, growing by 24,663. Population is expected to increase by 10.1% between 2023 and 2028, adding 26,317.
- From 2018 to 2023, jobs increased by 9.3% in Washington County, AR from 121,719 to 133,028. This change outpaced the national growth rate of 3.6% by 5.7%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate increased from 66.7% to 67.8% between 2018 and 2023.
- Concerning educational attainment, **20.3% of Washington County, AR residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (0.9% below the national average), and **6.4% hold an Associate's Degree** (2.6% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2023 are Restaurants and Other Eating Places, Education and Hospitals (State Government), and Education and Hospitals (Local Government).




#### Sep 2023 Labor Force Breakdown



#### **Educational Attainment**











## **Job Trends**






Washington County, AR had a September 2023 unemployment rate of 2.38%, decreasing from 2.60% 5 years before.




#### **Millennials**

Washington County, AR has 55,086 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 52,065.




#### **Retiring Soon**

Racial diversity is low in Washington County, AR. The national average for an area this size is 105,300 racially diverse people, while there are 78,344 here.




#### **Veterans**

Washington County, AR has 4.68 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 2.41 per 1,000 people.




#### **Property Crime**












## **Top Industry Employment Concentration**















## **Top Occupation Employment Concentration**




